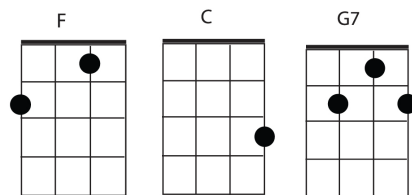


This Land Is Your Land

REPEAT CHORUS

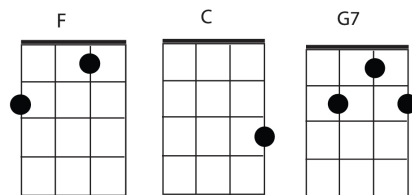
