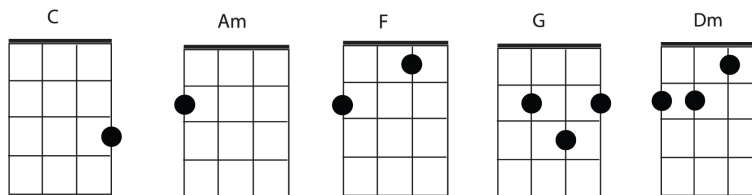

***[Advanced Option]:**

Rather than playing G for two full measures in the verses, you can do two split measures of [Gsus4 - G] [Gsus2 - G]
